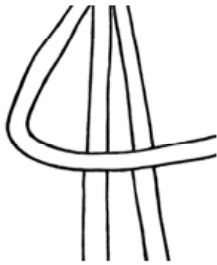
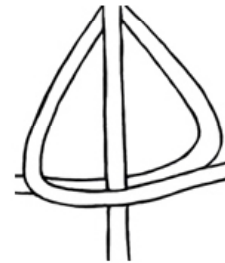


### macramé knot technique: square knot



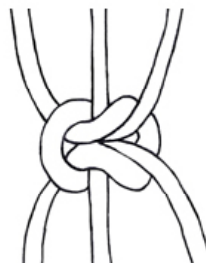
1. Start with 3\* cords- one 'base cord' in the center and two 'knotting cords on the left and right. Bring the left knotting cord over the base cord so both cords together look like the number "4".

2. Bring the right knotting cord under the base cord so that both cords together look like a mirrored number "4".



3. Bring each loose end through the loops. The left side will go down through the right loop and the right will come up through the left.

4. Repeat the last steps in reverse by bringing the left cord under the base cord and the right cord over the base cord. Bring the loose ends through the loops- left end comes up through the right loop and the right end goes down through the left loop.



5. Pull cords tightly to complete your square knot.

\*some designs use 4 cords- two "base cords" and two "knotting cords".
